### Search Instructions

The fastest way to identify and validate a dissertation is to enter the last seven characters of the UMI order number. If you don't have this, enter a word or phrase into the search terms field or the author's last name and the first four words of the dissertation title.

**Search terms** - Enter a word or phrase related to the dissertation. Use "quotation marks" to search for exact phrases.

**Order Number** - Enter the last seven characters of the UMI order number. (Example: for citation DA9412718, you should enter "9412718")

**Author** - Enter the author's last name or the author's last name, first name. (Examples: "Smith" or "Smith, Jane")

**Title** - There's no need to enter the entire title. Usually, the first four or five words will be sufficient to identify the dissertation.

You may choose from either unbound, shrink-wrapped print copies or PDF files.

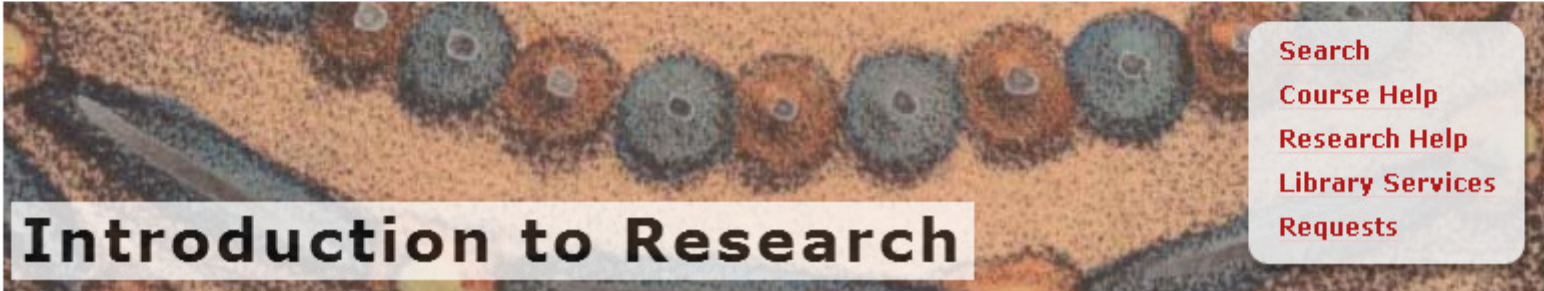

Finding Dissertations

Using ProQuest Dissertations & Theses database to find PhD dissertations

ProQuest Dissertations & Theses database contains records for PhD dissertations from 1861 through the present, and it allows you to search via keyword, date or institution. This is often the fastest way to find electronic versions of Cornell dissertations.

There are two ways to find Cornell dissertations. You can search [Dissertations & Theses @ Cornell University and the Weill Medical College](#), a subset of ProQuest Dissertations & Theses, or go to [ProQuest Dissertations & Theses](#) and choose the Advanced Search. In a search box, type "Cornell"; from the adjacent drop-down menu, select School name/code and enter your search terms in the remaining search boxes to target your search. From the results, you can use citations to search the Cornell Library catalog for individual titles. In some cases, results will have the full-text of the dissertation and/or links to purchase the dissertation.

Using the Library Catalog to find theses and dissertations at Cornell
